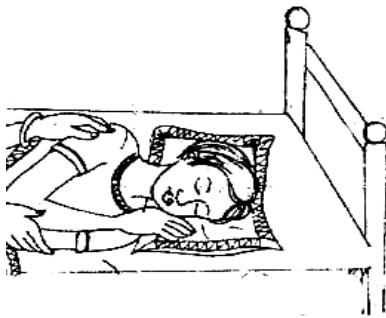
JACK AND JILL
